Education for Underprivileged Children

PEC sanctioned an amount of Rs. 5 lakh to 'Shirdi Sai Baba School', Faridabad, established by 'Shirdi Sai Baba Temple Society'. This contribution went towards sponsoring free education with books, copies, Stationary, school bags, uniforms and food for 333 rural and underprivileged children studying at 'Shirdi Sai Baba School' at Sai Dham, Faridabad. The Project was completed on 4th May, 2016.



Mid Day Meal

PEC sanctioned an amount of Rs. 5 lakh to ISKCON Food Relief Foundation (IFRF), towards the cost of the deficit in providing mid day meals at MCD schools in Central Delhi, under 15 Point Programme of Planning Commission. The Mid-Day meal scheme is aimed at providing supplementary nutrition to school children with the overall objective of enhancing enrolment, retention and participation of children while simultaneously improving their nutritional status. This amount helped cover the deficit cost for meals of 2426 students in 12 MCD schools. The Project was completed on 4th August, 2016.



Cataract Operation Camps under Project 'Drishti'

PEC associated with project 'Drishti' of 'Anugraha Drishtidaan' through a contribution of Rs. 2.50 Lakh, under which two Eye Screening and Cataract Operation Camps were organised at Baran/Kota District Rajasthan which included distribution of spectacles & medicines. In these camps, a total of 763 patients were screened; spectacles/dark glasses were distributed amongst 472 patients; medicines were distributed for 532 patients; and a total of 85 patients underwent Cataract Surgeries.



Helping the Disabled Regain Mobility & Dignity

PEC contributed Rs. 5 Lakh towards the project titled 'Helping the Disabled Regain Mobility & Dignity'. Under this project, 132 differently-able people were provided with 33 artificial limbs, 52 callipers for Polio Patients, 19 Aluminum Crutches (Pair), 14 Tricycles and 14 Wheel Chairs through Bhagwan Mahaveer Viklang Sahayata Samiti (BMVSS), in Delhi.



Swachh Bharat Abhiyan – Construction of Toilets

PEC sanctioned Rs. 27.39 lakh towards Construction & Maintenance of Public Toilet Complex in Khajuri Khas Fly over near Pillar No. 8 (Opp. Bikaner Sweets) at Khajuri Khas Chowk, North East Dist., Delhi through Sulabh International keeping in line with the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. The said toilet complex includes 11 WC (6 for males and 5 for females) + 1WC for PH and 6 Urinals. The toilet complex has been completed and was inaugurated on 26th August 2016.
